

# Tucson Open and Scholastics

January 20-22, 2012

**LOCATION:** The Holiday Inn Palo Verde, 4550 S. Palo Verde Rd., Tucson, AZ 85714.  
If coming from out of town, take I-10 to Palo Verde Rd. (exit 264B) and go North a 1/4 mile.  
Hotel rates (if by 1/6): \$89 (single) - \$109 (suite). Reservations: (520) 746-1161, mention "SACA".

**SECTIONS:** *Open, Reserve* (U1800), and *Booster* (U1400): 5/SS. 3-day or 2-day schedule is available.  
*Scholastic I* (K-6 / U1000) and *II* (K-6 / U600):  
Two separate 1-day tournaments with two sections each day (Saturday and Sunday); 4/SS.  
All players must be in grade K-6 and rated under 1000 or 600 (USCF) as of January Supplement.  
Chess sets and boards provided for tournament play only. **Chess clocks not provided!**

**ENTRY FEES:** *Open:* \$60      *Reserve:* \$45      *Booster:* \$30      (if received by Wednesday, 1/18)  
**GMs and IMs EF is FREE. EF for Masters will be returned as per SACA policies.**  
**Juniors (under 20) and Seniors (50+):** \$10 discount for Open and Reserve sections only.  
**Late fee:** Additional \$10 if after 1/18 or at the site.  
*Scholastic I and II:* \$15 each day or \$25 for both days      (if received by Wednesday, 1/18)  
**Late fee:** Additional \$10 if after 1/18 or at the site.

**REGISTRATION:** USCF membership is required for all sections.

**SCHEDULE:** *3-day schedule:* Fri. 7p; Sat. 10a, 5p; Sun. 9a, 4p. **Time control:** 40/2, SD/1  
*2-day schedule:* Sat. 10a, 1:30p, 5p; Sun. 9a, 4p. **Time control:** Rd. 1-2: G/90; Rd. 3-5: 40/2, SD/1  
*Scholastic I and II:* Round 1 at 10am, then as available for Rounds 2-4. **Time control:** G/40  
**Byes:** ½ point byes (2 max.) are available for all rounds if requested prior to start of round two.

**PRIZES:** *Open section (\$\$G):* \$600 (and plaque) \$400 - \$300 - \$200; Top X, A, B/below \$150 each.  
Trophy to Top Junior (U20), Top Junior (U14), and Senior (age 50+).  
*Reserve section (b/38):* \$250 (and plaque) - \$150 (and plaque); Top C and D/below \$100 each.  
Trophy to Top Unrated, Top Junior (U14), and Senior (age 50+)  
*Booster section:* Trophy to 1<sup>st</sup> (and clock), 2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Place, Top E, Top U1000/Unr, Top Junior (U11)  
*Scholastic I and II:* Trophy to 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Place (each day).  
Top player who plays both days will also receive a digital clock. (*Scholastic I and II*)
