



# Regional Championships

## (South Regional Qualifier #1)

### March 10, 2012

**Directions:** **DeGrazia Elementary. 5051 West Overton Road, Tucson, AZ 85742.** Take I-10 to Cortaro Farms Rd (Exit 246) and drive a ½ mile east to Hartman Rd. Turn left (north) on Hartman and go 1 mile to Overton Rd. Turn right (east) and go a ¼ mile, to DeGrazia Elementary.

**Description:** **USCF rated.** Individual format with 5 rounds divided into 4 sections. Open to students in grades K-9. Players may play up, but only qualify (see below) for the section that they participate in.

**To Register:** Registration is done online on the [SACA website](http://www.sazchess.org) by Friday, March 9 at 8:00 pm.

Kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> graders without a USCF ID number can contact SACA about getting a Junior Tournament Player (JTP) membership, but must request a number by Thursday, March 8 at 8:00 pm. E-mail [scholastic@sazchess.org](mailto:scholastic@sazchess.org) to request a JTP membership.

**Required information for JTP membership includes: Name, address, and birth date.**

**Entry Fees:** \$15 per player. Payment is required upon registration.

**Schedule:** Check-in is not required. Drops must be declared by 8:15 am. Pairings are posted at 8:45 am. Announcements start at 8:55 am and play begins at 9:00 am! Round times are 9:00, then as available. **There will be a Coach's meeting after the start of round 3.**

**Time Control:** Game in 40 minutes (per player). **Bring chess clocks and sets, none provided.**

	<b>Elementary Trophies:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> - 15 <sup>th</sup> Individual	1 <sup>st</sup> - 6 <sup>th</sup> Team
	<b>Primary Trophies:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> - 15 <sup>th</sup> Individual	1 <sup>st</sup> - 6 <sup>th</sup> Team
	<b>K-1 Trophies:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> - 10 <sup>th</sup> Individual	1 <sup>st</sup> - 4 <sup>th</sup> Team

Medallions awarded to players scoring 4.0 or more points that do not win an Individual Trophy. Medals to all K-1 players not receiving a trophy. Participation Ribbons to all. Team scores consist of only the top 4 scores in the section.

## 2012 AZ State Scholastic Championship

**Qualifications:** To play in the **AZ State Scholastic Championships**, a player must qualify a "slot" at a Regional Qualifier. A school may bring the number of players equal to the number of slots qualified at all Regional Qualifiers +1; a team qualifying exactly two slots in a section may bring four players in that section. Players qualify slots by: **K-1 section:** play at least 4 rounds OR score 3 points; **Primary K-3, Elementary K-6, and Junior High K-9:** score at least 3 points at a qualifier; **High School Grades 9-12:** do not have to qualify. A player may not qualify more than one slot, regardless of the number of qualifiers played.
