- TIME CONTROL:** Game in 40 minutes + 5 sec increment per move.
- SCHEDULE:** **4 Rounds:** At 9:30 AM / 11:15 AM/ 1:15 PM/ 2:45 PM. Closing Ceremony immediately after the rounds are completed. Pairings may be done as to make the best match-ups possible.
- TROPHIES:** Trophies, certificates and medals in each section. Special trophies / medals in each subdivision.
